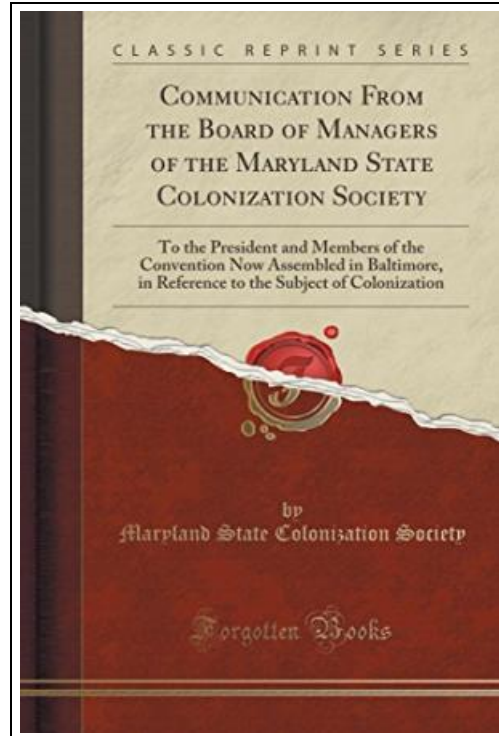

The Board of Managers, in doing thus, have performed perhaps, fully, all that was required of them by the resolution above mentioned: but inasmuch as the call for a Convention grew out of what took place at the Annual Meeting of the State Society, it has been thought, that it would not be unacceptable to the Convention, were they to reiterate briefly, the facts and views which were stated at Annapolis - as well as to present such other considerations as have been suggested in the interval. The State Society exists for the purpose of promoting in Maryland the well known objects of the Colonization - scheme the removal of the free people of colour with their own consent to the Coast of Africa. It is independent wholly, at this time, of the American Colonization Society. This independence was the result of the convictions of many years experience of the inefficiency, so far as Maryland was concerned, of the general system.
