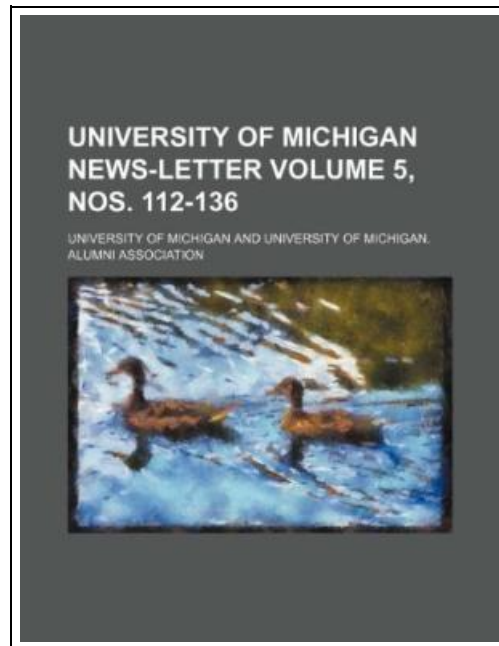

Williams, a graduate with the class of 18S9, Clarence W. Hubbell. a graduate with the class of 1893, and George H. Fenkell, a student during 1891-92. Mr. Williams is professor of experimental hydraulics at Cornell University. Mr. Hubbell is chief engineer of the Detroit waterworks, and Mr. Fenkell is chief engineer of the waterworks at Erie, Pa. Dr. Victor C. Vaughan, dean of the medical department of the University of Michigan, responded to toasts at Michigan alumni banquets at Duluth, Minn., andMilwaukee, Wis., February 13 and 14, respectively. The subject of his remarks at Duluth was Medicine as a Liberal Education, and the subject for the Milwaukee toast was, Bloodless Surgery. Herman Russell, who held the Michigan Gas Association fellow.-hip at the University of Michigan during the year 1900-1901, has been selected as supetintendent of a gas company in San Franrisco.
